(c) According to the Ministry of Agriculture and Irrigation, the supplies of nitrogen were to the extent of 83 % of the allotments made to the State during August—October period. For phosphates the supplies were over 100 % of the allotments.

TRAINS CANCELLED IN BIHAR

290 SHRI M. KADERSHAH: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state :

(a) the number of trains cancelled during the period 2nd November to 9th November, 1974 in Bihar on account of the agitation led by Shri Jaiprakash Narayan; and

(b) the total loss in revenue on account of the cancellation of these trains; and

(c) whether a request for the cancellation of trains was made by the Government of Bihar or by the Central Government?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI L. N. MISHRA): (a) A total of 27 pairs of passenger carrying trains were cancelled fully/partially during 2nd to 9th November, 1974 on account of Patna and Bihar Bandhs.

(b) The approximate loss in earning is estimated to be Rs. 1-35 lakhs.

(c) These cancellations were made in consultation with Bihar Government.

COCHIN REFINERY

291. DR. Z. A. AHMAD : Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that breach of contracts by two foreign firms with the Cochin Refinery in 1973 has affected the performance of the refinery; and

(b) if so, what are the names of the firms, the nature of the contracts and how it adversely affected the working of the refinery?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS (SHRI K. D. MALAVIYA : (a) and (b) During the year 1973, Cochin Refinery had two contracts; one with C.F.P. of France for supply of crude oil and the other with M/s. Triton Shipping Inc. of U.S.A. for transportation of crude.

The contract with C.F.P. provided that it was renewable every year. With effect from 1st January, 1974. C. F. P. did not renew the contract in view of the difficult crude supply situation in the world' market. There was, however, no breach of contract by C. F. P. In May, 1973 M/s. Triton Shipping Inc. unilaterally terminated the contract with Cochin Refineries Limited. The non-renewal of the crude supply contract by C.F.P. and the termination of contract by Triton together with other factors such as non-availability of the right type of crude, have affected the throughput and profitability of the Cochin Refinery.
