Reference to Alleged Ghastly crimes Committed by Contractor in Ghanoo-dih Coal Mines

SHRI KALYAN ROY (West Bengal): Mr. Chairman, Sir, through you, I wish to bring to the attention of the Minister of Energy the ghastly crimes which are being committed by the contractor in the Ghanoodih coalmines of the Bharat Coking Coal Ltd. supported by the General Manager and the Chairman of the B.C. C.L.

I Mr. Deputy Chairman in the Chair]

Sir, on the 19th February when the night shift workers were returning to their quarters a gang of men, whose number is unknown, led by one contractor, Mr. Surajdeo Singh who is very closely connected with the General Manager and the Chairman of the B.C.C.L., attacked the colliery workers with sten guns, bren guns and other kinds of fire arms. Sir, three top leaders of the All India Trade Union Congress Shri Raghurai Singh, Shri Subhas Rai and Shri Lalita Singh were killed on the spot and eight are in the hospital
