Will the Minister of LAW, JUSTICE AND COMPANY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware of the fact that use of black-money and foreign influence and aid is made in elections in the country; and

(b) if so, what steps Government have taken in this regard?

विधि न्याय और कम्पनी कार्य (श्री एच० आर० गोखले) : (क) और (ख) सरकार के पास अभ्यर्थी या उसके निर्वाचन अभिकर्ता द्वारा निर्वाचन में किये गये केवल उस व्यय के बारे में जानकारी होती है जिसे लोक प्रतिनिधित्व अधिनियम, 1951 की धारा 77 के अधीन इस प्रकार के व्यय के लेख में दर्शित किया जाता है। निर्वाचनों में

विदेशी धन और प्रभाव के उपयोग का जहाँ तक संबंध है, विदेशी अभिदाय (विनियमन) विधेयक 1973 का, जो राज्य सभा में 24 दिसम्बर, 1973 को पुरःस्थापित किया गया था, अन्य बातों के साथ यह उद्देश्य भी है कि कुछ व्यक्तियों, संगठनों अथवा अन्य एसोसियेशनों द्वारा, जिनमें निर्वाचन लड़ने वाले अभ्यर्थी और राजनीतिक दल भी सम्मिलित हैं, विदेशी अभिदाय या आतिथ्य स्वीकार करने तथा उसका उपयोग करने का विनियमन किया जाये।

[The MINISTER OF LAW, JUSTICE AND COMPANY AFFAIRS (SHRI H. R. GOKHALE): (a), and (b) Government has only information about the expenditure incurred by the candidate or his election agent at the election, as shown in the account of such expenditure under section 77 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951. As regards the use of foreign money and influence in elections, the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Bill, 1973, introduced in the Rajya Sabha on 24th December, 1973, *inter alia* seeks to regulate the acceptance and utilisation of foreign contribution or hospitality by certain individuals, organisations or other associations which include candidates at elections and political parties.]

Holding up of Trains due to breakdown of Locomotives

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of trains held up en route during the last 6 months due to breakdown of locomotives;

fb) whether such break-downs have occurred in mail and express trains also; and

(c) if so, what steps are proposed to be taken to ensure that such breakdowns do not occur in future?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BUTA SINGH): (a) to (c) A statement is laid on the Table of the Rajya Sabha.

Statement

(a) The average number of trains held up en route during the last six months, due to break-down of locomotives was 21.7 per day (Steam— 11.1; Diesel—6.1; and Electric— 4.5) against 10.800 trains (Passenger and Goods) run daily.

(b) Yes, 4.7 breakdowns occurred on Mail and Express trains per day on an average during the last six months against 485 Mail and Express trains run daily.

(c) The following steps have been taken to minimize such break-downs:

(i) Refresher courses given to maintenance and running staff.

(ii) Thorough check-ups in the maintenance depots before locomotives, go out to pick up the trains.

(iii) Analysis of the causes leading to remedial measures, discussed at various levels.

(iv) Improvements in the designs of components and their raw materials.

(v) Both educative and punitive measures are adopted.
