REFERENCE TO REDUCTION IN SUPPLY OF FOODGRAINS TO KERALA

MR. CHAIRMAN: Mr. Kunjachen.

DR. K. MATHEW, KURIAN
(Kerala): On a point of order. Earlier,

[Dr. K. Mathew Kurian] on several occasions, our party had moved motions, Calling Attention Motions, on the serious question of the food situation in Kerala. You Sir, in your wisdom has allowed a mention. In the last Session of this House, we had moved a Calling Attention Motion on the very serious food situation in Kerala.

MR. CHAIRMAN: Let him complete.

DR. K. MATHEW KURIAN: I am only making a submission

MR. CHAIRMAN: Why?

DR. K. MATHEW KURIAN: I will tell you why. In the last Session of this House, we had moved a Calling Attention Motion on the serious food situation in Kerala. . .

MR. CHAIRMAN: It is not correct.

DR. K. MATHEW KURIAN: Whenever we have moved a Calling Attention Motion, whenever we have raised it, these Ministers have turned a deaf ear.

MR. CHAIRMAN: Kindly resume your seat.

DR. K. MATHEW KURIAN: If the hon. Minister can : . .

MR. CHAIRMAN: Do not take down anything.

(DR. K. MATHEW KURIAN *continued speaking*).

MR. CHAIRMAN: Yes, Mr. Kunjachen.

SHRI P. K. KUNJACHEN (Kerala): Mr. Chairman, Sir, at present the people of Kerala are dying due to starvation and the Government says that they are dying due to some other diseases. That is what is being stated by the Government. The Central Government has reduced the monthly quota of ration from 80,000 tonnes to 42,000 tonnes. After our request they have agreed to revise it to 10,000 tonnes more. Consequently the Kerala Gov-

ernment has reduced the ration from six ounces to three ounces. The people of Kerala cannot live by this ration. The Central Government must stop this step-motherly treatment meted out to Kerala. The Minister of Food is against the people of Kerala. He has denied the people of Kerala food on the plea that unless fertiliser is lifted from Ernakulam food will not be sent to Kerala. The Minister is not helping Kerala. He is not sending food to Kerala and the people there are dying of starvation. But he says that the people are dying due to gas-tro-enteritis and other diseases. The people cannot live with the rations. Under the present situation the Minister must come here and say what the Government is going to do to save the people of Kerala. Unless he comes to explain before the House we are going to resort to *dharna*.

DR. K. MATHEW KURIAN: Sir, on several occasions we have discussed the food issue before the House. We are not satisfied with the Minister's reply. Nothing has been done. The ration has been cut to three ounces.

SHRI MONORANJAN ROY (West Bengal): Similar situation exists in West Bengal.

DR. K. MATHEW KURIAN: Yes, similar situation existed in Bengal. No assurance has been given. Ration has been cut and the people of Kerala are dying due to starvation. They are on the verge of revolt. Therefore, we from our Party are going to sit in *dharna* in front of you until we get an assurance from the Government that the cut will be restored.

(At this stage, some hon'ble Members sat on the floor of the House near the Chair).

SHRI S. KUMARAN (Kerala): Mr. Chairman, Sir, Kerala is facing a grave and explosive situation...

SHRI VISWANATHA MENON (Kerala):
Let Kerala's voice be heard....
(*Interruption*).

(*At this stage the hon'ble Member sat on
the floor of the House near the Chair.*)

SHRI MONORANJAN ROY: Sir, in West
Bengal also the ration has been reduced. In
protest against the Government action I also
join the *dharna*.

(*The hon'ble Member sat on the floor of
the House near the Chair.*)

DR. K. MATHEW KURIAN: Let the Food
Minister come here and assure us what he is
going to do.

SHRI NIREN GHOSH (West Bengal): Let
Mr. Subramaniam come here and give a
statement.

SHRI LOKANATH MISRA (Orissa): I
would like to make a submission. I would
appeal to you to direct the Food Minister to
come and make a statement in the House, in
response to what has been stated by hon'ble
Members. Meanwhile I would appeal to
hon'ble Members to resume their seat so that
the business of the House gets transacted.

SOME HON'BLE MEMBERS: NO, no.

SHRI S. S. MARISWAMY: Mr.
Chairman, Sir,(*Interruption*).

DR. K. MATHEW KURIAN: The Food
Minister has yet to know the people of
Kerala.

SHRI S. KUMARAN: Sir, I was saying
something. Yes, I will say something. Kerala
is now facing a grave and explosive food
situation. Usually July, August and September
are lean months in Kerala. In addition to that
the massive floods, incessant rains, landslides
and the enormous destruction caused by these
natural calamities have left a trail of sorrow
for the people.

At this critical juncture the Central
Government cutting the quota of rice
to Kerala is a very cruel step. As a result
of this the State Government can distribute only
303 of rice and 1.5 oz. of wheat, for an adult per
day. Yesterday I received a teleprinter
message from the Kerala Food Ministry. Sir,
they said the stock position of rice in the FCI
godowns in Kerala is very critical. There is at
present a stock of only 9,000 tonnes of rice in
Kerala and the available stock also is out evenly
distributed within the State. For want of
stocks in the main depots of the FCI. The
average daily arrival has come down to less
than 300 tonnes. Unless the Food Corporation
of India arranges for movement of
special wagons of rice from its depots
in Andhra Pradesh and elsewhere, breakdown
in the supply of even this meagre quantity
of rice cannot be ruled out. In the circum-
stances, I request the Central Government
to make the necessary arrangements for the
immediate allotment of 30,000 tonnes of rice in
addition to the 45,000 tonnes of rice already
allotted during this month, and for a regular
allocation of 90,000 tonnes of rice and 45,000
tonnes of wheat to Kerala in order to enable the
State Government to maintain the ration. I
would like to warn the Government that unless
sufficient allotments are made, the people of
Kerala will have to rise in revolt against the
stepmotherly attitude of the Central Gov-
ernment. Sir, every time we raise the Kerala
food situation here, the Government of India
gives the ready-made reply "We will
consider it sympathetically when the
time comes." In the circumstances, we
have no other way to fight against the policies
of the Government. So I also join other Kerala
Members in the *Dharna*, until the
Government gives a clear assurance.

SHRI VISWANATHA MENON: Let
them forget their party affiliation*. and let
them come here.
(*Interruptions*).

MR. CHAIRMAN: Order, please. Please resume your seats. The Minister in charge of Food will meet Members of the Rajya -Sabha who have raised this question and he will make a statement before the House adjourns to-day. , Therefore, I suggest that hon. Members may resume their seats. Let us carry on our business with some dignity.

श्री राजनारायण : श्री वे मंत्र : हु
चुके हैं, हमारा सोशलिस्ट पार्टी का राज्य
शाखा के सेक्रेटरी ।

(At this stage, the hon. Members who had sat on the floor near the Chair went back to their seats.)

MR. CHAIRMAN: Don't take down anything.

(SHRI RAJNARAIN confirmed speaking).

श्री राजनारायण : श्रीमन्, हमारा पॉइन्ट आफ ऑर्डर है । बहुत ही विनम्रता के साथ मैं व्यवस्था का प्रश्न आपके समक्ष प्रस्तुत करना चाहता हूँ और आपको इस बात के लिए अपने दिल से बधाई देना चाहता हूँ कि आपने आज केरल के संबंध में जो व्यवस्था दी, वह आपने बहुत ही अच्छा किया और जो सरकार की गैतानी हरकतें होती हैं उनको प्रचलित नहीं होने दिया । आपने यह काम अच्छा किया कि एग्जिक्यूटिव मिनिस्टर को इस बात के लिए तैयार किया और आदेश दिया कि आज सदन के उठने से पहले केरल के सम्मानित सदस्यों से मिल कर केरल की खाद्य समस्या के बारे में विचार करें । उसी तरह से मैं चाहूँगा कि आप अपनी उदार दृष्टि और दरिया-दिल हमारे साथ भी रखें । श्रीमन्, मैं चाहूँगा कि आप हमारी वाणी से प्रभावित हों ।

आप देखते हैं, बिहार में मंडगाई, भ्रष्टाचार, बेरोजगारी, अन्न की कमी के प्रश्न को लेकर तमाम आंदोलन हो रहा है और श्रीमन्, 5 तारीख को गोली चली, हमारे एक साथी जो कि यहां किसी से कम नहीं है, श्री जगदेव प्रसाद सिंह को जानबूझ कर गफूर सरकार ने गोली से मरवाया है । वे जनता के माने हुए नेता हैं, पिछड़े वर्ग के लोगों के भी नेता

MR. CHAIRMAN: You are not resuming your seat. You are not hearing me. You must give some opportunity for the Chair to explain. You are not hearing anybody. Therefore, I have asked them not to take down anything.

श्री रबी राय : श्रीमन्, हमारा पॉइन्ट आफ ऑर्डर है । राजनारायण जी आपकी अनुमति से एक व्यवस्था के प्रश्न पर बोल रहे थे तो आपने बीच में उनको टोका कि आप सुन नहीं रहे हैं । ये तो अपने पॉइन्ट आफ ऑर्डर पर बोल रहे हैं । इस तरह के बहुत से पॉइन्ट आफ ऑर्डर पर आप सुनते हैं, फिर इन को क्यों मना करते हैं । मैं आपसे अनुरोध कर रहा हूँ कि आप उनके पॉइन्ट आफ ऑर्डर को सुन लें ।

MR. CHAIRMAN: I will suggest to Mr. Rajnarain to come and meet me separately. I will discuss with him and if he has got any problem I will try to solve it. But this is not the way of doing things.

श्री राजनारायण : श्रीमन्, मेरा पॉइन्ट आफ ऑर्डर है कि क्या इस सदन में 2 तरीके अविचार हो गए ? आप अनुभवशील आदमी हैं, बुजुर्ग आदमी हैं, मैं चाहता हूँ सदन में दो स्टैंडर्ड्स न हों । केरल के उन सम्मानित सदस्यों को मैं बधाई देता हूँ कि उन्होंने धरना देकर केरल की खाद्य समस्या पर सरकार का

ध्यान आकर्षित कर दिया, उसी तरह से मैं चाहता हूँ कि इस बिहार में जो गोली चली है 5 तारीख को जिसमें जगदेश प्रसाद जी मारे गए हैं, उस पर भी ध्यान दें और सरकार को आदेश दें। श्री जगदेश प्रसाद को जानबूझ कर मारा गया है। वे वहाँ मंत्रों रह चुके हैं, पिछड़े वर्ग के प्रतिनिधि हैं और वहाँ से एक एक्स-मालिकेदार ने पुलिस के मिल कर उनके ऊपर गोली चला दी।

MR. CHAIRMAN: Is that all? I will look into the matter. Please resume your seat.

REFERENCE TO ACUTE DROUGHT CONDITIONS IN VARIOUS STATES

SHRI PRAHMANANDA PANDA (Orissa): There was only firing in the air.

SHRI NIREN GHOSH (West Bengal): No. It was raised by me and Mr. Sitaram Singh yesterday. Fifteen Congress MPs have issued a statement. It is not a small matter.

श्री रवी राय (उड़ीसा) : फायरिंग हुई, लोग इन्जर्ड हुए।

SHRI BRAHMANANDA PANDA: Because, the mob was unruly.

श्री प्रकाशवीर शास्त्री : मैं यह समझता था कि श्री ब्रह्मानन्द पण्डा जो इस सदन के माननीय सदस्य हैं, मेरी इस बात से सहानुभूति प्रगट करेंगे कि मैंने उनके राज्य में जो गोली चली है उस घटना का थोड़ा सा उल्लेख किया और वहाँ जो अन्न के अभाव में स्थिति उत्पन्न होती जा रही है उसकी ओर इशारा किया, लेकिन न जाने उन्होंने क्यों मेरी बात में व्यवधान उत्पन्न किया...

श्री ब्रह्मानन्द पण्डा : मैंने यह नहीं कहा। आपने कहा गोली चली तो मैंने कहा है कि—
There was firing in the air, because the mob was unruly.

SHRI NIREN GHOSH: How do you know?

SHRI BRAHMANANDA PANDA: I know.

श्री रवी राय : गोली चली है, लोग अस्पताल में भरती हुए हैं, उनको मालूम है।

श्री ब्रह्मानन्द पण्डा : तुमको मालूम नहीं है।

श्री रवी राय : "आपको" कहिए। "तुमको" नहीं कहते हैं, अनपार्लियामेंटरी है।
