## Inadequate production of Telephone equipments and underground cables

(a) whether it is a fact that due to inadequate production of equipments and

under-ground cables, a large number of applications for new telephone connections are on the waiting list all over the country; and

(b) if so, what steps Government propose to take to ease the position in the next financial year?

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI S. D. SHARMA): (a) and (b) There is a large waiting list for telephone connections in the country totalling nearly six lakhs as on 31-12-1974. The demand for additional telephones could not be met fully for want of resources, both material and financial. Development of capacities of factories for producing the necessary equipments, cables, etc. has also been limited by the same considerations.

Under the present constraints it has been proposed to provide about 1.2 lakhs telephones during 1975-76.
