- (a) whether Government have conducted a study on the increasing danger of pollution posing a serious health hazard to these people in this country;
 - (b) if so, nature of such study; and
- (c) if not, whether Government have plans for conducting such study in future?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA): (a) and (b) study of pollution of various types is one of the functions of the National Environmental 'Engineering Research (NEERI). Institute Nagpur. Institute has so far carried out short term air quality survey in 4 major cities namely, Bombay, Delhi, Calcutta and Kanpur in 1968-69 for period of 1-2 months for each city. They have also conducted studies on water pollution in Jamuna, between Agra and Wazirabad (Delhi) Ganga near Kanpur, Damodar in Durgapur and Hooghly in Asansol region (Calcutta).

(c) For a proper assessment of effect of pollution it is necessary to undertake long term studies. The NEERI, Nagpur can undertake specific studies when these are sponsored by local bodies.

†Workers' participation in manage-Ment

1447. SHRI DEORAO PATIL: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY AND CIVIL SUPPLIES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government propose to allow workers' participation in the management of sick textile mills owned by the Central Government; and
 - (b) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY AND CIVIL SUPPLIES (SHRI B. P. MAURYA): (a) and b) Provisions for workers participation at various levels of management are being considered for incorporation in a com-

prehensive Industrial Relations Bill which is being processed by the Ministry of Labour. As and when the Bill is enacted, the question of workers' participation in the management of the nationalised textile mills would be decided in the light of the relevant provisions.
