

III. Plantation Schemes sanctioned

V. Repatriates Cooperative Finance and Development Bank

Apart from the scheme, mentioned above, a co-operative institution named as the Repatriates Co-operative Finance and Development Bank has been set up at Madras for promoting the rehabilitation of repatriates from Sri Lanka and Burma in Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala and Pondichery. The Bank provides finances for economic programmes of production, trade and business undertaken by repatriates or co-operative of repatriates. Loans are given either directly or through commercial banks on the basis of the guarantees.
