Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that near about 41 per cent Kendriya Vidyalayas are not functioning in permanent buildings; and

(b) if so, the reasons therefor and the steps taken by Government to complete construction of permanent buildings for these Vidyalayas?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MO. ALI ASHRAF FATMI): (a) No, Sir.

(b) Construction of school Buildings mainly depends upon availability of land and funds for this purpose. Efforts are made to ensure that adequate budgetary support is given to Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan for completion of construction of permanent buildings where land is available.

(a) the number of new schools proposed to be opened under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan as well as Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya Scheme, District-wise;

(b) whether Government have any role in implementation of these schemes;

(c) if so, the details thereof; and

(d) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MD. ALI ASHRAF FATMI): (a) to (d) 46,075 new

schools in all the states and Union Territories except Goa under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) and 717 residential schools for girls in educationally backward blocks under the Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya Scheme (KGBV) have, been approved to be opened during the year 2004-05, under these two centrally sponsored schemes. The State-wise list of new schools sanctioned under SSA is given in Statement-I (See *below*) and district wise list of KGBV schools is given in Statement-II

The State Government concerned is responsible for the setting up of these schools.
