Running of an Express Train between Ranch} and Delhi

Biweeldy 77/78 Utkai Express and one daih 1st and 2nd through service coach by 11/12 Delhi-Howrah Express and -onnected trains are available for through passengers between Delhi/New Delhi and Tatanagar. These through trave: facilities have been found to be adequate for the present level of traffic.
