Running of an Express Train between Ranchi and Delhi

718. SHRI B. R. MUNDA : Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that the people of Hatia, Ranchi, Jamshedpur, Bokaro Steel City and suburban villages are facing great hardship in travelling from these places to the big cities of the Northern parts of India in the absence of any direct express train; and

(b) if so, whether Government propose to run an express train between Ranchi and Delhi with arrangements of attaching bogies for the people of Jamshedpur and Bokaro Steel City?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MOHD. SHAFI QURESHI) :

(a) No. At present, two-bi-weekly

through service coaches viz. one 1st and 2nd and one 2-tier sleeper are running between Delhi/New Delhi and Hatia for the convenience of through passengers between Ranchi/Bokaro Steel City and Delhi. Bi-weekly 77/78 Utkal Express and one daily 1st and 2nd through service coach by 11/12 Delhi-Howrah Express and connected trains are available for through passengers between Delhi/New Delhi and Tatanagar. These through travel facilities have been found to be adequate for the present level of traffic.
