

Crushing capacity for oil steels

787. -SHRI PRAKASH VIR SHASTRI: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state the total crushing capacity for various kinds of oil-seeds in the organised sector in the country during the Fourth Five Year Plan and as envisaged in the Fifth Five Year Plan?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI ANNASAHEB P. SHINDE): No precise information is available on the installed capacity of the oil milling industry in the country. The installed capacity for vegetable oils by expeller process in the organised sectors is estimated to be 12 lakh tonnes per annum in terms of oilseeds.

In view of the large capacity already existing in the country, expansion of capacity for crushing of oilseeds is not envisaged. However, in the case of cottonseed crushing, the Govt. is encouraging to have further capacity and the present position of cottonseed crushing is as under:—

It is estimated that all the cottonseed available in the country in 1978-79 will be cru'lied for which the availability will be 43.20 lakh tonnes. Hence the same capacity will be required in 1978-79.

The capacity at present registered in the D. G. T. D. for the manufacture of various vegetable oils by solvent extraction process is 23.13 lakh tonnes in terms of expeller oilcakes.

Ration cards for the Distribution of Fertilizers

788. SHRI SANAT KUMAR RAHA: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased *th* state:

(a) whether Government proposes to introduce ration card system in all the States to ensure fait and equitable distribution of fertilisers to farmers; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI ANNASAHEB P. SHINDE): (a) There is no such scheme under consideration of tht Government of India. The Government oi India makes only State-wise allocations of fertilisers from imports and domestic production. The system of interval distribution within a State is left to the State Government concerned. It is for the Stat* Go. etnments to decide whether a card system is to be introduced to ensure a fait distribution of fertilisers to the farmers.
