(c) In addition to fiscal and monetary measures adopted by Government to check the inflationary trend in prices, several steps are being taken to increase production of foodgrains in the country. In addition, regulatory measures to curb hoarding of foodgrains and other essential commodities, and price control measures have been adopted. With a view to removing distortions in the prices of foodgrains in the deficit States, restrictions on the movement of coarse grains have been removed and movement of wheat on trade account is also being permitted to improve availability of wheat in the market.

To the extent necessary, import of foodgrains is also being made.
