*272. SHRIMATI MAIMOONA SULTAN: SHRI GANESH LAL MALI: J

Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Central Government have directed the State Governments to shelve all new programmes of mineral development and natural resources exploitation in view of the present economic situation; and
- (b) if so, what are the details of such programmes and schemes proposed to be shelved during the Fifth Five Year Plan period in Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING (SHRI MOHAN DHARIA): (a) No, Sir.

(b) Does not arise.

SHRI GANESH LAI. MALI: Sir, the southwest part of Rajasthan is very rich in minerals and the development of southwest Rajasthan especially and the rest of Rajasthan in general, depends upon mineral development. If, as per direction of the Central Government, the State shelves future mineral development for the next five years, the economy of the State as a whole will be shattered because the development of the State mostly depends upon mineral development. Therefore, may I know from the lion. Minister what steps are proposed to be taken to ensure that the shelving of the mineral development programmes does not seriously hamper the economic development of the State, throwing thousands out of employment?

SHRI MOHAN DHARIA: I have already said that there is no proposal to shelve this plan. So, naturally this question does not arise.
