(c) if so, the details thereof; and

(d) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) A list of Parliamentary Constituencies not having a Kendriya Vidyalaya is given in the Statement (See below).

(b) to (d) Kendriya Vidyalayas are not opened constituency-wise. The aim and objective of opening a Kendriya Vidyalaya is to cater to the educational need of the wards of transferable Central Government employees including Defence and Para-Military forces by providing common programmes of syllabi.
