Statement

Staustics of total earnings before deductions and the corresponsing average daily number of employees in factories are collected under the Payment of Wages Act, 1936. The Act covers all employees earning less than Rs. 400 per month, earnings being defined to include basic wages, cash allowances, annual bonus, arrears and money value of concessions. Based on these statistics, index numbers of money earnings for workers in factories are calculated on base 1961=100. These index numbers when deilated by the All India Consumber Price Index numbers for Working Class (base shifted to 1961=100) give the corresponding index numbers of real earnings. Index numbers for the years 1962, 1966, 1969, 1970 and 1971 are given below :---
