THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI TAPAN SIKDAR): (a) to (c) Keonjhar is a Revenue District and is part of Dhenkanal Telecom District (SSA) which is headed by Senior Administrative Grade Officer. Each Telecom District or SSA is a basic unit of operation for the purpose of administration, charging, routing and numbering plans. As per the existing policy, SSAs are not being bifurcated.
