House-to-house check to detect tax evasion Cases

1365. SHRI GIAN CHAND TOLU: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that house-to-house checking to detect tax-evasion cases has been started at Calcutta; and

(b) if so, what safeguard Government have imposed against the abuse of added powers given to Income-tax officials?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI K. R. GANESH): (a) In a selected area of Calcutta, a house-to-house survey operation has been commenced recently.

(b) This operation is primarily intended to check whether persons who have taxable income are assessed to tax or not. It is being conducted within the existing provisions of the Income-tax law and do not involve giving of any added powers to the Income-tax officials.
