Rural industrial project for Cachar

253. DR. R. K. CHAKRABARTI: Will the Minister of INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AND SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Central Government have sanctioned any rural industrial project for Cachar district in Assam; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI Z. R. ANSARI): (a) and (b) Out of 57 new district projects sanctioned for the Fifth Five Year Plan, 2 new projects were allotted to Assam State. The State Government had suggested districts of Cachar and Nowgong for the locations of these two projects and the suggestion has been ac-

cepted by the Ministry of Industrial Development. The preliminary work, such as recruitment of staff, their training and conducting of techno-economic surveys in all the new projects all over the country were to be completed by the end of the Fourth Five Year Plan, so that the actual implementation of the programme could start from the 1st April, 1974. The State Government is being urged to complete the preliminaries without any further delay.
