†Misuse of import licences

262. SHRI SHYAMLAL GUPTA: Will the Minister of COMMERCE be pleased to state the names of firms/parties against whom action for misusing the import licences has been initiated during the last three years and the present position in respect of each case?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE (SHRI A. C. GEORGE): Information about the firms/parties against whom action has been initiated after due investigation, is published in the Weekly Bulletin of Industrial Licences, Import Licences and Export Licences, copies of which are available in the Parliament Secretariat Library.

Whenever an alleged misuse comes to the notice of the Government, enquiries are started to ascertain whether there has been misuse or not. As a number of cases is being investigated into by the Import Trade Control authorities all over India, it is considered that the labour involved in the collection of the present position of all the cases will not be commensurate with the results achieved, especially as the situation will vary from time to time.

(a) whether it is a fact that an action Committee under the Chairmanship of a Member of Planning Commission was set up for augmenting production of industrial units in public sector; and

(b) if so, what are the details of the suggestions made by the Committee and what action Government have taken thereon?

वित्त मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्री के. आर. गणेश) : (क) और (ख) योजना आयोग के एक सदस्य की अध्यक्षता में सरकारी उद्यमों के संबंध में एक कार्य समिति की स्थापना की गयी है। इस समिति को सरकारी उद्यमों के कार्य-निष्पादन में सुधार करने के उपायों का पता लगाने का काम सौंपा गया है। समिति द्वारा दिये गये कुछ महत्वपूर्ण सुझावों का संबंध नीचे बताये गये कामों से है :

- (1) प्रबन्ध-कार्य को पुख्ता बनाना,
- (2) संयंत्र और निगम स्तर पर संगठनात्मक ढांचे में परिवर्तन ;
- (3) संयंत्र प्रबन्ध में सुधार ;
- (4) अनुरक्षण के काम का विकेंद्रीकरण ;
- (5) संतुलनकारी और अड़चनों को दूर करने से संबंधित सुविधाओं की व्यवस्था ;
- (6) सामग्री प्रबन्ध कार्मिकों को प्रोत्साहन प्रदान करने, उत्पादन-आयोजन और नियंत्रण के कार्य में सुधार ;

(7) कार्य संचालन की समय पर समीक्षा और नियंत्रण की उपयुक्त व्यवस्था करना ;

(8) बेहतर निगम आयोजन ;

(9) गवेषणा और विकास कार्यो तथा अन्य तकनीकी सेवाओं को मजबूत बनाना ;

(10) बिक्री तथा विपणन के कार्य में सुधार ;

(11) औद्योगिक संबंधों में सुधार, और

(12) काम को कई पारियों में चलाना ;

इनमें से अधिकांश सिफारिशों को सरकार ने मंजूर कर लिया है और वे क्रियान्वयन के अलग-अलग दौरों में हैं ;

†[THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI K. R. GANESH): (a) and (b) An Action Committee on Public Enterprises has been set up under the Chairmanship of Member, Planning Commission. The Committee is entrusted with the task of identifying the steps necessary to improve the performance of public enterprises. Some of the important suggestions made by the Committee relate to :

(i) strengthening of management;

(ii) changes in organisational structure at the plant and corporate level;

(iii) improvement in plant management;

(iv) decentralisation of maintenance activities;

(v) provision of balancing and debottlenecking facilities;

(vi) improvement in materials management, motivation of personnel, production planning and control;

(vii) introduction of suitable machinery for timely review and control of operations;

(viii) better corporate planning;

(ix) strengthening of Research & Development activities and other technical services;

(x) strengthening of sales and marketing efforts;

(xi) improvement of industrial relations; and

(xii) Multi-shift operations.

Most of these recommendations have been accepted by Government and are at various stages of implementation.]
