THE Minister of DEFENCE (SHRI JAGJIVAN RAM): (a) and (b) Accounts for the Republic Day Celebrations, 1974 have not yet been finalised. Steps are being taken to collect the details of accounts from the authorities concerned as early as possible. A statement showing the expenditure incurred on this years Republic Day Parade and Beating Retreat Ceremony by the Central Government will be laid on the Table of the House after the accounts have been finalised and compiled.

(i) Scientific Mining, including sand-stowing;

(ii) Re-structuring and re-organisation of mines;

(iii) Control over distribution under the Colliery Control order; and

(iv) Utilisation of medium coking and blendable coal along with prime coking coal to the maximum extent possible.
