Statement III

Steps taken to arrest price rise, etc. of cotton varn

- (i) Cotton textile mills have been instructed by the Indian Cotton Mills Federation to maintain varn prices prevailing on the 28th March, 1974 upto May, 1974, in respect of all counts and in all forms. (These prices are comparable with prices prevailing in October/November, 1973);
- (ii) Mills will allow direct lifting by nominees of State Governments, apex co-operative societies and State Handloom/Powerloom Corporations; and
- (iii) Mills, or groups of mills, individually, or through their Regional Associations, will try to open depots in important centres of handloom concentrations.
