*322. SHRI O. P. TYAGI : Will the Minister of EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to an article on Gurudev Tagore which was published on the occasion of the 27th Anniversary of UNESCO in "Art in India-Today", a publication of the United Nations Council of Indian Youth;

(b) whether it is a fact that Gurudev Tagore painted nearly 2,000 pictures which were exhibited in various world capitals; and

(c) what steps Government propose to take for exhibiting Tagore's painting in the country?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WELFARE AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE (SHRI D. P. YADAV): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) According to knowledgeable sources it is estimated that there are over 1500 paintings of Gurudev Tagore. Some of these paintings have been included in the exhibitions organised abroad.

(c) Most of the paintings of Gurudev Tagore are already exhibited at the National Gallery of Modern Art, Rabindra Sadan, Santiniketan and a number of art galleries in India. Some of these paintings are also included in the Circulating Exhibitions in India and also in the Exhibitions sent abroad.

(b) if so, what are the details thereof; and

(c) by when self-sufficiency in coarse grains is likely to be achieved ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI ANNASAHAB P. SHINDE): (a) to (c) The goal of self-sufficiency is envisaged in terms of overall output of all foodgrains taken together rather than in terms of individual foodgrains or groups of foodgrains. The targets in respect of foodgrains including coarse grains as visualised in the draft Fifth Five year Plan are given below:—

Wheat	30.0	38.0
Maize	6.5	8.0

Pulses	11.0	14.0
Total food grains :	114.0	140.0

It is expected that the fulfilment of these targets will make the country not only self-sufficient in respect of foodgrains but also leave a cushion for building up a buffer stock.
