If a passenger persists in smoking in a bus, its crew can require him to alight from the vehicle forthwith and may stop the vehicle and keep it standing until the passenger has alighted. A person, who refuses to alight from a bus in such circumstances, may be forcibly removed by the conductor/driver and shall be guilty of an offence. No report of any passenger having persisted in smoking inside a bus, when asked not to do so, has been reported so far and, therefore, the occasion for taking action has not arisen.

Survey regarding prostitution in the country
