of wagons for movement of cement. With a view to removing these constraints and maximising production of cement, rail transport movement of cement is regularly scrutinised by a high level committee of Secretaries every month to extend such assistance to factories as may be necessary and possible. A Standing Linkage Committee has also been established under the Department of Mines and Metals and the various cement factories have been linked to the different coal The supply of coal to the various cement factories is reviewed by the Linkage Committee every month. A Monitoring Cell has also been established at Calcutta consisting of the representatives of the Railway Board and the Coal Mining Authority to review every 10 days the supplies of coal to various cement factories. Besides these measures taken for maximising production out of the existing capacity, additional capacity by way of letters of intent/licences to the extent of about 16.56 million tonnes has also been approved. Out of this, a capacity of about 1.76 million tonnes is expected to come into production during 1974.
