Written Answers

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अमरीकी कंपनी के साथ तकनीकी सहयोग के प्रस्ताव के लिए एकमुक्त रकम और रायल्टी के भुगतान के आधार पर जबकि उक्त कम्पनी के साथ सहयोग का अल्प विदेशी पूंजी विनि-योग और रायल्टी के आधार पर सहमित दी गयी थी।

विदेशी सहयोग के प्रस्तावों पर विचार करते समय वैज्ञानिक एवं श्रीद्योगिक अनु-सन्धान परिषद् की आपत्तियों को ध्यान में में रखा गया था । चूकि देश में विकसित प्रौद्योगिकी आवेदकों द्वारा प्रस्तावित दिशा-ओं पर उपर्युक्त वस्तुओं के निर्माण के लिए पर्याप्त नहीं थी, अतः दोनों ही मामलों में विदेशी सहयोग का अनुमोदन किया गया था:

fTHE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI M. B. RAN A): (a) to (c) Government have approved two schemes one for the manufacture of electrostatic photo copying machines (Special duplicators), coated paper and toner ink wiht technical collaboration from M/s. American Photo Copy Equipment Company, U.S.A. and the other for manufacture of Electro-static photo copying machines and electro photobased paper in technical and financial collaboration with M/s. Van Der Grinten, NV, Venlo, Netherlands.

The proposal for technical collaboration with the American Company was approved on the basis of payment of lumpsum plus royalty, while the collaboration with the Dutch Company was approved an the basis of minority foreign investment plus royalty.

The objections of Council of Scientific and Industrial Research were taken into account while considering the foreign collaboration proposals. As the technology developed indigenously was not adequate for the manufacture of the above items on the lines proposed by the applicants, foreign collaboration was approved in both the cases.}

The Committee will examine and report on the system of recruitment to the All India Services and the Central Services, Class I and-Class II, followed by the Union Public Service Commission and recommend such changes in the scheme of examinations and in the selection methods as would give adequate emphasis to knowledge, skills and qualities appropriate to the role and functions of the Services in the context of the tasks of national developments and re-construction.

The Committee will deal, among others, with the following matters in particular:—

- (1) the desirability of having, instead of three examinations', as at present a single competitive examination for the All India and other Class L Services re-cn'jtment to which is made through the "I.A.S. etc. Examination;
- (2) the adequacy of the Personality Test prescribed in the present Scheme of "I.A.S. etc. Examination;

. (3) the desirability of including more subjects particularly Engineering, Commerce, Agriculture and other technical subjects, and excluding any of the existing subjects, as optional papers in the scheme of the IA.S. etc. Examination, and of making any other changes in the scheme of the written part of that Examination;

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- (4) the number of chances that should be allowed at the I.A.S. etc. Examination;
- (5) the measures necessary to implement the decision of Government about the use of all languages included in the Eighth Schedule to the Constitution, along with English, as media for the I.A.S. etc. Examination;
- (6) the arrangements to be made for review at regular intervals of the syllabi of subjects prescribed for the various examinations to take into account developments as regards courses of study conducted by educational institutions;
- (7) the system of direct recruitment to the Central Services and posts Class I and Class II, otherwise than through the competitive, examinations, with particular reference to the measures required to speed up recruitment;
- (8) the feasibility and the procedure to be adopted for bringing down the proportion of candidates to the number of posts to which direct recruitment is required to be made through competitive examinations held by the Commission as well as through selection by interview;
- (9) any special arrangements required in the Commission for efficient handling of recruitment to scientific and technical posts;
- (10) any other matter which in the opinion of the Committee has a bearing on the aforesaid items or which may be referred to the Committee by the Commission.
