THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI SHARAD YADAV): (a) No, Sir, because as such no life is specified for modern aircraft which may continue in operation as long as they are maintained in an airworthy condition in accordance with the procedure prescribed by the manufacturers and approved by the Director General of Civil Aviation.
