Delay in Installation of new telephone connections in the Varanasi Sub-Division

*600 SHRI MULKA GOVINDA REDDY: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of new telephone connections pending installation even after making due payments by the applicants in the Varanasi Sub-Division in Uttar Pradesh; and

(b) if so, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI K. BRAHMANANDA REDDY). (a) and (b) Against 995 demand notes for new connections issued upto 14-3-1974, payments have been received for 780 connections, out of which 660 connections have already been provided. There has been delay in provision of some connections due to some applicants having changed their addresses, or the premises where phones were required to be installed

not having been found in the occupation of the applicants, or the connections requiring erection of very long lines. Most of the connections in respect of which payment has been made are likely to be provided in about a month's time except those cases in which the locations have not been finally decided upon by the applicants or which involve considerable line constructions work
