THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI UMA SHANKAR DIKSHIT) : (a) to (c) While extremist violence has continued to show a downward trend there have been reports of a few such incidents of violence during this year, particularly, in West Bengal, Bihar and Andhra Pradesh. These incidents have involved attacks on landlords, police and other Government officials and a few cases of heinous offences. The State Governments concerned continue to exercise vigilance and are taking all possible steps to contain extremist violent activities.
