This was examined in an inter-departmental meeting held in the Planning Commission, wherein it was suggested that the Oil Palm Plantation in Kerala might continue to be with the Kerala Plantation Corporation but the requisite assistance for further developing the plantations might be provided by the Centre. The Planning Commission accordingly desired that the possibility of providing this assistance in the form of Central participation in the equity capital of the Corporation or formation of a separate subsidiary under the Corporation be explored by the Ministry of Agriculture with the Government of Kerala. Some further discussions have since been held with the State Government and the details are being worked out.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT (SHRI M. B. RANA):
(a) and (b) Suggestions were received from several quarters including various

maritime State Governments for setting up shipyards in their States. A Techno-Economic Working Group was, therefore, set up to evaluate both technically and economically, various sites including Murud-Janjira, proposed by the State Governments for setting up shipyards and to indicate the types and sizes which can with advantage be constructed at the sites recommended. A final decision will be taken after the report of the Techno-Economic Group is received.
