MINISTER OF STATE IJV THE MINISTRY OF WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI OM MEHTA): (a) and (b) No specific target of providing house si les to landless and house-siteless families in rural areas during the Silver Jubilee Year of Independence was fixed undei the Central Sector Scheme for provision of house sites Sector Scheme for provision of house sites to landless workers in Ttiral areas, which is administered by the Ministry of Works and Housing. The Silver Jubilee pro gramme, inter alia, envisaged selection of one Jayanti Village in each block Ior all round development, including provision of house sites and construction ol impioved housing, particularly for the Harijans and the landless labour. It was further envisaged tbat an at tempi should be made to provide at least IOO houses Ior the Harijans in these villages. The Stale Governments were expected to uiilisc Governments were expected to uiilisc ihe funds available under Ihe various on-going Plan and non-Plan Schemes in the State Sector, Central Sec un and State Sector, Central Sec un and Centrally sponsored Sectors, for ihe purpose. On the basis of ihe prdgres's reports received Irom State Governments and Union Territory Administrations- by the Ministry of Agricul-uic (Department of Comnuuiy Development), who are responsible for coordination of all activities in the Jayanti Villages, a statement showing ihe State-wise position ol provision of house-silrs and houses in Jayanti Villages is attached,
