

**Observations of Self-reliance Committee regarding over-invoicing and under-invoicing by certain firms**

SHRIMATI AZIZA IMAM:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to refer to the answer to Unstarred Question No. 64 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 24th July, 1973 and state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Self-Reliance Committee, under the chairmanship of Shri M.G. Kaul, has referred to cases of over-invoicing and under-invoicing by certain big firms;

(b) if so, what are the details in this regard; and

(c) what steps Government proposes to take against those firms?

for the current financial year for expenditure on tourism schemes included in the Fourth Five Year Plan. The break-up of this allocation on various schemes is given in the statement appended. These are continuing schemes. No new schemes are being taken up in the last year of the Fourth Plan.
