of the provinces arc not tit all getting any chance? For example. Sir. last year, in the admissions, none from Kerala or Maharashtra was taken. Does the Government think that people in Kerala or Maharashtra do not have intelligence enough to see that they are admitted to this All-India 'nsti-Uite of Medical Sciences'.'

DR. KARAN SINGH: I do not think anybody can say that the people of Kerala and Maharashtra do not have intelligence, as the proceedings of this House arc, 1 would say, sufficient to prove. But. Sir. the position is. out of 45 seats, 7 seats arc reserved for Scheduled Castes and 3 for Scheduled Tribes. Now on the other 35 seats, there are no reservations State-wise. 1 believe that as many as 15.000 to 20.000 students every year compete for these 35 seats. So it is really a question which student is able to come up to the top in this examination.

SHRr K. P. SUBRAMANIA MENON: Only Delhi and Punjab get it.

DR. KARAN SINGH: Probably Kerala is better. From my State there is nobody. I doubt if there is anybody from my State.
