viding liberal assistance for the adoption of the new pattern should be introduced in the Fifth Five Year Plan. The relevant Resolution adopted at the meeting is reproduced below:—

"The Comr tittee examined administrative and financial implications of the decision to adopt the uniform pattern o 10+2+3. It was of the view that i might not be possible for the State Covernments to find the resources required for this programme fully in the State Sector. It, therefore, recommends that a Central Scheme providing liberal assistance for the adoption of the new pattern should be introduced in the Fifth Five Year Plan. This is all the more necessary as the programme has to be implemented by all the States simultaneously and in a coordinated manner."

The scheme for the adoption of the common pattern of education, estimated to cost Rs 30 creres, was proposed to be included in the Fifth Five Year Plan. The salient features of the scheme are given in pages 46-48 of this Ministry's publication entitled "CABE STANDING COM-MITTEE PROCEEDINGS" copies of Parliament which are available in the As the Planning Commission have not agreed to any provision in the central sector of the Fifth Plan for this scheme, it is now for the State Governments/Union Territories to take a firm decision to adopt the pattern during the Fifth Five Year Plan period and to provide the necessar funds within their plan allocations.

The Consultants have recommended development of the Shipyard in two stages. Stage 1 consists of the further work to be done aimed at the completion of the Integrated Development Programme complementing facilities required to make it more effective. Stage 2 comprises provision of a building-dock for building ships of 60,000 DWT to 80,000 DWT.
