(a) whether Government are satisfied with India's know-how in steel manufacture in comparison with the developing countries ; and

(b) if not, the steps taken by Government to acquire better know-how?

THE MINISTER OF, HEAVY INDUSTRY AND STEEL AND MINES (SHRI T. A. PAI) : (a) and (b) By and large, the know-how available in the country for manufacture of steel can be considered adequate. However, for certain special qualities of steels and sophisticated products, know-how would have to be acquired from developed countries for which action is taken as required.

THE MINISTER OF HEAVY INDUSTRY AND STEEL AND MINES (SHRI T. A. PAI) : (a) The present capacity of power equipment manufacturing units of the Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited/Heavy Electricals (India) Limited is in the range of 3500 MW per annum, depending upon the product mix.
