(a) whether any plans have been drawn up by Government to develop a heavy machine building complex in the country during the Fifth Plan period;

(b) if so, the details of the schemes; and

(c) the estimated expenditure on the complex ?

THE MINISTER OF HEAVY INDUSTRY AND STEEL AND MINES (SHRI T. A. PAI) : (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The present assessment is that the proposed plant should have a capacity to manufacture approximately 20,000 tonnes of rolling mill and other equipment.

(c) NIDG has been commissioned to prepare a feasibility report for this project. This report will reflect the approximate expenditure likely to be incurred on this project.

Steel Projects in South India

THE MINISTER OF HEAVY INDUSTRY AND STEEL AND MINES (SHRI T. A. PAI) : (a) Work on the Vijayanagar Steel Project is to be continued during the Fifth Plan period-

(b) Vijayanagar and Visakhapatnam Steel Projects are not scheduled to go into production in the next four years-However, the first phase of the Salem Steel Project which envisages production of 30,000 to 35,000 tonnes of cold rolled stainless steel sheets and strips from imported hot rolled materials* is expected to go into production towards the end of the Fifth Plan.
