THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF LAW, JUSTICE AND COMPANY AFFAIRS (SHRI BEDA-BRATA BARUA): (a) and (b) The application made by Birla Jute Manufacturing Company Limited for the establishment of a cement clinker plant was referred to the M.R.T.P. Commission on 16-7-1973 and the undertaking requested the Commission for fixation of a date for public hearing in the third week of August, 1973 as it wanted the assistance of the Advocate who was not available before the middle of August. The Commission gave a hearing on the 18th September, 1973. No request was received from any other Birla concern for postponement of consideration of its application for setting up cement plants.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS (SHRI SHAH NAWAZ KHAN): (a) and (b) In the context of steep and continuing increases in the price of crude oil and the need to curtail the growth in consumption of petroleum products in the country, tlie targets for refining capacity to be achieved at the end of Fifth Plan are still under consideration. Therefore, no firm decision has yet been taken on the proposal for Ihe expansion of Haldia Refinery.
