Student—DTC Clashes

Will the Minister of SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT be pleased to state the steps being taken by Government to augment the fleet of buses particularly in the University area in view of the frequent clashes between the Delhi Transport Corporation and the students on account of inadequate bus services ?

THE MINISTER OF SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT (SHRI KAMALAPATI TRIPATHI) : A statement is laid on the Table of the Sabha.

Statement

In order to meet the transport requirements of the students adequately, in addition to the normal bus services operating on the various routes touching the University and colleges in Delhi, the number of DTC special trips was increased from 591 previously to 700 after the reopening of the University in July this year. The number of special trips exclusively for girl students has also been increased from 28

to 71. To meet any eventualities that may arise as a result of missing of trips due to breakdowns of vehicles or other reasons, arrangement for 20 stand-by buses has also been made.

2. An Apex Committee comprising the Dean of Students' Welfare, Delhi University, Additional District Magistrates, representatives of the Delhi University Students' Union and a D.T.C. official considers all fresh demands relating to bus services received from the students. On the recommendation of this Committee, steps are taken to provide additional services, as and when required.

3. Senior officers of the D.T.C. have been deputed to attend promptly to the genuine grievances, demands and suggestions received from the students. The D.T.C. staff has also been instructed to avoid confrontation with the students.
