Setting up of Marine Resources Development Commission

- (b) if so, when it will be set up and what will be its functions?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRIAL DE-VELOPMENT AND SCIENCE AND TECH-(SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM): (a) and (b) The National Committee on Science and Technology have made a recommendation for the establishment of Marine Resources Development Commission. The proposal is under examination and detailed composition and functions are vet to be worked out.

Discovery of a New Type of Plastic by an Indian Scientist

- (a) whether Government are aware of the discovery of a new type of plastic by an Indian; Mr. Abdul H. Quraishi which may revolutionise the metal casting and forging industry, and
- (b) if so, what steps have been taken to utilise the new discovery for India's industrial development?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRIAL DE-VELOPMENT AND SCIENCE AND TECH-NOLOGY (SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM): (a) and (b) According to the information available Dr. Quraishi's discovery has not yet been brought to the notice of the Government. As a result of inquiries it has been found that development of the plastic referred to has been reported in one of the Indian journals.
