THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE (SHRI A. C. GEORGE) : (a) India has entered into Trade and Payments Agreements envisaging payments in non-convertible rupees with the following countries:

USSR, Poland, German Democratic Republic, Czechoslovakia, Hungary, Rumania and Bulgaria.

Similar arrangements have also been made with the Democratic Peoples Republic of Korea.

In accordance with these agreements, annual trade plans are prepared for trade between India and these countries.

India has also entered into trade agreements with the following countries :

Yugoslavia, Peoples Republic of Mongolia.

A trade pact has also been made with Democratic Republic of Vietnam.

Copies of all these agreements are available in the Library of the Parliament, and lists of commodities for export to and import from these countries are appended to these agreements.

(b) No new trade agreement has been entered into with any other Socialist country during the current year.]
