(b) The important development schemes expected to be undertaken in the Cochin Port during 1973-74 are extension of open berth, construction of super tanker berth, facilities for handling fertilizers and containers, provision of facilities for handling liquid ammonia, purchase of four wharf cranes, one hopper grab dredger, one high power tug, one hopper suction dredger, housing schemes etc.
