#### [REPLACING OF DEFENCE AIRCRAFT

859. SHRI RAM SAHAI : Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state: the number of Harvard and Vampire aircraft replaced so far by those made in India and the number of such aircraft proposed to be replaced during the year 1973-74 ?]

#### रक्षा मंत्री (श्री जगजीवन राम) :

फ्लाइंग इन्स्ट्रक्टर स्कूल में पहले से ही 6 किरन (एच० जे० टी०-16) वायुयानों ने हार्वर्ड को प्रतिस्थापित कर दिया है। जून, 1973 तक यह संख्या बढ़ कर 14 हो जाएगी। एयर-फोर्स अकादमी में हार्वर्ड वायुयान को किरन वायुयान के द्वारा जनवरी, 1974 तक बदल देने की

सम्भावना है। अभी एडवांस उड़ान प्रशिक्षण वेम्पायर वायुयान पर फाइटर ट्रेनिंग विंग में दिया जा रहा है, उसे 1974 के अन्त तक किरन वायुयान पर दिये जाने की सम्भावना है।

f[THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI JAGJIVAN RAM) : Six Kiran (HJT-16) aircraft have -already replaced the Harvatds at the Flying Instructors School. This number will go up to 14 by June, 1973. The Harvard aircraft at the Air Force Academy are expected to be replaced by Kiran aircraft by January, 1974. The advanced flying training now being given in Vampire aircraft in the Fighter Training Wing is expected to be imparted in Kiran aircraft by the end of 1974.]

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND REHABILITATION (SHRI G. VENKAT-SWAMY) : (a) A Regional Workers' Education Centre is functioning in Madras City since October, 1960.

(b) Besides the Regional Director, there are 6 Education Officers and the requisite supporting clerical and Class IV staff.

**CULTURAL CO-OPERATION**

84. SHRI KALI MUKHERJEE : Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Indo-Soviet Cultural Society (I.S.C.U.S.) and the Union of Soviet Cultural Society (U.S.C.S.) signed a plan for cultural co-operation in 1973;

(b) if so, the salient features of the plan; and

(c) whether any such plan with any other country has also been signed?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI SURENDRA PAL SINGH) : (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The two organisations will promote and strengthen friendship and co-operation between the peoples of the two countries by acquainting them with the life, history, culture and development of science and technology of the other. In order to achieve this objective, exchanges of delegations, teachers, public personalities, scientists, students and artists are envisaged. Exchanges of books, films and photographic exhibits are also proposed.

(c) The Indo-GDR Society has an agreement with its counterpart organisation. Government is not aware of any similar plan with any other country.

**{TRAINING PLACES FOR SKILLED MAN-POWER**

254. SHRI K. L. N. PRASAD : Will the Minister of LABOUR AND REHABILITATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government propose to create about 2,00,000 training places for apprentices to meet the need of skilled man-power during the Fifth Five Year Plan period?

(b) whether Government also propose to train 2,000 workers in 25 Industrial Units;

(c) the number of persons who have been imparted training as apprentices during the last two years; and

(d) what is the total number of industries and trades that are covered under the Apprenticeship Act?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND REHABILITATION (SHRI G. VENKATSWAMY) (a) Under the Apprentices Act, 1961, training places are located in designated trades by means of surveys in the establishments covered under the Act. The target of training places to be located during the Fifth Five Year Plan has not yet been fixed.
