Will the Minister of SUPPLY be pleased to state :

(a) the number of the Directors and deputy Directors separately who are working in DGS & D for the last three years ;

(b) whether Government have enquired into their sources of income during this period and verified their assets in comparison with their non sources of income;

(c) the number out of them who are regularly filing their detailed annual statements of income to Government ; and

(d) what action Government propose to take against those officers whose income has been found to be in excess of their known sources of income and whether Government have conducted any surprise raids at their residences with a view to ascertaining their standard of living and prepare an inventory of the money and articles in their possession ?

THE MINISTER OF SUPPLY (SHRI HAH NAWAZ KHAN) : (a) The number Directors and Deputy Directors who have worked in the DGS & D during the last three years irrespective of the period for which they have worked as such, is as under: —

(b) No, Sir.			

(c) There are no instructions requiring these officers including the DGS&D officers submit their detailed *annual statements* of income. However, in accordance with the provisions of Central Civil Services (Conduct) Rules, 1964, the DGS&D officers like other Government officers are required to submit an *annual return* in respect of immovable property. They are also required to

to report any transaction exceeding Rs. 1,000/- in respect of movable property.

(d) No case has come to the notice of the Government during the period in question where the assets of the officers of the rank of Director and Deputy Director have been found to be in excess to their known sources of income. However, suitable action will be taken as and when such a case is established against any officer.

The Department of Supply and the DGS&D have no authority to organise raids at the residences of the officers. A raid, according to law can be made by the police in the course of investigations etc. of any case, if they are satisfied about the need of such an action.
