RAO): (a) As the second stage of Idikki Hydro Electric Project comprises addition of peaking capacity only required for firming up power generation in the Southern Region and will not increase the annual quantum of power generation, the Government of Kerala have proposed to the Government of India to take over the project as a Central Sector Scheme.

(b) The Planning Commission have sanctioned the Scheme for financing from the State Plan resources.
