SABOTAGE OF RAILWAY LINE IN ANDHRA PRADESH

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether a number of cases of missing fish-plates, dog-spikes and keys on both sides of the rail in various parts of Andhra Pradesh have recently come to the notice of the Government,

(b) if so, what are the details in this regard; and

(c) what security measures have been taken to ensure normal running of trains and prevent sabotage of the railway lines?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI L. N. MISHRA) : (a) Yes.

(b) A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

(c) Besides such measures as patrolling of track, escorting trains in affected areas, collection of intelligence and exchanging the same with Government Railway Police etc. which are normally taken to ensure safety of rail travel, the security arrangements in Andhra Pradesh, where several such incidents occurred during the recent 'Mulki' agitation, were tightened up by providing re-inforcements of Central Reserve Police, Border Security Force and Railway Protection Special Force. The Territorial Army personnel were also deployed to man the trains in this area. Patrolling by village Talariis and Railway Engineering gangmen was also introduced and armed guards were posted at important bridges.

## STATEMENT

Southern, South Central and South Eastern Railways run through the State of Andhra. The details of incidents of missing fish plates, dog-spikes and keys etc. on each of these Railways as from 1-10-1972 onwards are as given below:—
