STATEMENT

Government are taking all possible steps to tackle the unemployment problem through accelerated growth and specially designed programmes which will form an integral part of the Fifth Plan for generating a substantial increase in employment opportunities in various sectors. The Central Ministries and State Governments have been advised to formulate schemes in the Fifth Plan with due stress on employment promotion so as to ensure a significant impact on the employment problem by the end of the Fifth Plan. A special cell is proposed to be constituted in the Planning Commission for formulation of additional employment opportunities for educated job seekers during 1973-74.

A Steering Group on Employment and Manpower has been constituted by Planning Commission which has set up various Working Groups and Task Forces to go into the several aspects of employment and manpower. It will take some more time before their reports are available. An Expert Committee on Unemployment set up by the Ministry of Labour and Employment is also examining the various related aspects and their report is still awaited. These would be taken into account in formulating a comprehensive strategy of employment during the Fifth Plan. It is not possible to indicate at this stage how many jobs are likely to be created annually during the Fifth Five year Plan period.
