- (b) According to available information. a total of 1897 rebels surrendered between the 24th August, 1968 and the 15th August. 1971, pursuant to the offer of amnesty announced by the Government of Assam. 806 more surrendered between the 15th August 1971 and the 30th September, 1972, pursuant to the liberalised offer of amnesty approunced on the 15th August, 1971,
- (c) In view of the deterioration in the law and order situation in Mizoram, following an increase in the activities of underground Mizo hostiles, the offer of amnesty was not renewed after the 30th September.

PLAN TO MODERNISE POSTAL SERVICES 1087. SHRI K. L. N. PRASAD: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government propose a 4 crore plan to mechanise postal work in the country;
- (b) if so, what are the main features of the proposed plan; and
- (c) the steps that are being contemplated during the Fifth Plan in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI H. N. BAHUGUNA)': (a) Under the Fifth Five Year Plan which is still under consideration of Government, an outlay of Rs. 4.85 crores is proposed to modernise and mechanise the postal services

- (b) It is proposed to acquire Postal Stationery Vending Machines, Stamp Emitters, Coin Stackers, Money Order Booking Machines; Franking Machines, Numbering and Dating Machines, Stamp Cancelling Machines, Conveyors, Battery Driven Trucks and Sorting Machines for modernising post office counters and delivery and sorting branches.
- (c) (i) It is proposed to set up a Research and Mechanisation Cell to process these cases.
- (ii) It is also proposed to set up 4 regional workshops for maintenance and

repairs of these machines. These workshops may also progressively undertake manufacture of some of the simpler machines subsequently
