

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVILAVIATION (SHRI PRAFUL PATEL): (a) At Chennai Airport, Airports Authority of India (AAI) is expected to handle 90400 MT export cargo in 2005-06 as against 80745 MT handled during the year 2004-05, which is an increase of 12%.

(b) International freight airlines which are carrying cargo from Chennai Airport and the cities connected by them are:- Air France: Chennai -Abudhabi - Paris; Air Mauritius: Chennai - Mauritius; British Airways: Chennai - Stansted, Chennai - Stansted - Hongkong; Cargolux: Chennai -Luxemburg; Lufthansa: Chennai-Sharjha-Frankfurt; Srilankan Airlines: Chennai-Colombo, Emirates: Chennai-Dubai; Kuwait Airways: Chennai - Kuwait; Singapore Airlines: Chennai - Singapore, Chennai - Sharjah -Brussels, Chennai - Sharjah -Amsterdam - JFK; Qatar Air: Chennai -Doha -Amsterdam, Chennai - Doha - Munich.

(c) AAI has already established an interim cargo handling facility at Coimbatore. Besides, air cargo complexes are operated by State Government Undertakings at Airports at Bangalore, Hyderabad, Vishakhapatnam, Trivandrum, Calicut and Cochin.
