OVERSEAS TRADE

140. SHRI SANAT KUMAR RAHA: the Minister Of SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT be pleased state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the over all share of Indian Shipping in the country's overseas trade is only 20 per cent;
- (b) whether the country is entitled to carry 50 per cent of its seas trade in Indian bottoms;
- (c) whether any steps are being taken to increase the share of Indian shipping in the contry's trade during the fifth Plan.
- (d) if so, what are the details of the steps being taken in this respect; and
- country's (e) how much of the overseas trade is expected to be carried in Indian bottoms by the of the fifth Plan?

OF SHIPPING THE MINISTER AND TRANSPORT (SHRI RAJBAHADUR):

- (a) and (b) Yes, Sir.
- (c) to (e) The Fifth Plan for shipping has not yet been fixed. As more than two-thirds of our overseas trade consists of movement bulk commodties Government have, since the begining of the Third Plan laid emphasis on acquisition of bulk present carriers and tankers. As at there are 8 tankers of 4.28 lakhs dwt, 23 bulk carriers of 9,68 lakhs and 10 OBOs of 467 lakhs dwt operation in the overseas trade. addition 17 tankers of 8.81 lakhs dwt, 8 bulk carriers of 5.89 lakhs dwt and 3 OBOs of 3.18 lakhs dwt are under construction. It is the aim of ernment that Indian shipping should carry a minium of 50 per cent of the overseas trade by the end Fifth Plan, as also to participate the cross trading to the extent possible.

PRODUCTION OF GRAIN IN RABI SEASON

- 141. SHRI N. G. GOARY: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE pleased to state:
- (a) the probable production grain in the Rabi Season 1972-73; and
- (b) the states where the crash programme for producing more crops was carried out; and the results thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE INTHE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI ANNASHIB SHINDE): and (b). The Emergency Agricultural Production Programme for increasing production of foodgrains during Rabi-Summer, 1972-73, is being implemented in almost all the States. main emphasis under the programme is on quick-maturing m.nor irrigation schemes, such as energisation tubewell|pump sets, lift projects, etc. As a result of this programme and the beneficial winter rains, area and production of rabi crops are expected to show an increase over 1971-72 in some of the States like Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Punjab and Haryana. In the States of Maharashtra, Gujarat and Rajasthan where rains have continued to be deficient in the rabi season, rabi crops out put may register some fall. Apart from the continuance of adverse weather conditions in some States, the overall shortage of power and fertilizers also might affect the production during the rabi season to some extent. While increase over last year's rabi duction is expected, in the country as a whole, firm estimates of production of rabi foodgrains would become available at the close of the agricultural year, i.e. sometime in July-August, 1973.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT (SHRI M B RANA) (a) Lengths of National Highways at present passing through the States of Harayana and Punjab are 600 Kms and 961 Kms respectively In Punjab, lengths totalling to 436 Kms were added to the National Highway System in two instalments only in July 1971 and March 1972

(b) The amount allotted to the Governments of Haryana and Punjab for the repairs etc of National Highways during the last 3 years is as under —
