## **STATEMENT**

Crop production targets are fixed :for the year as a whole and not separately for each season.

Firm estimates of production for 1972-73 would become available at the close of agricultural year, i.e., sometimes in July-August, 1973. The available information on weather and crop conditions indicates that during Kharif season 1972-73, crops were damaged by deficient and erratic rainfall in several parts of the country \*particularly to Maharashtra, Gujarat, Rajasthan and parts of Andhra Pradesh and Mysore. On the other hand, Kharif production might possibly show some increase in the States of Uttar Pradesh, Orissa, Assam and Punjab.
