

DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR MALNAD AREA

248. SHRI H. S. NARASIAH: Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government of Mysore has recently sent a Development Plan for Malnad Area;

(b) if so, the details of the plan;

(c) whether the said plan is likely to be included in the Fifth Five Year Plan; and

(d) whether any Indo-Danish project for the development of cattle breed, manufacture of dairy products and other activities is likely to be taken up under the project?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING (SHRI MOHAN DHARIA): (a) No, Sir. The Planning Commission has not received from the Government of Mysore any development plan for Malnad Area.

(b) and (c) Does not arise.

(d) No such proposal has yet been forwarded for the consideration of Planning Commission.

SEMINAR ON SATELLITE TELEVISION

(a) whether it is a fact that a Seminar on Satellite Television was held in the month of December 1972 in New Delhi;

(b) if so, the names of the countries which participated in this Seminar; and

(c) what are the recommendations of the Seminar?

THE PRIME MINISTER (SHRI-MATI INDIRA GANDHI): (a) A United Nations Panel on Satellite Television was held in New Delhi and Ahmedabad in December, 1972.

(b) The countries which participated in the United Nations Panel meeting were the following:

Australia, Indonesia, Iran, Ivory Coast, Japan, Kenya, Malaysia, Mongolia, Morocco, Nigeria, Philippines and Thailand.

In addition, experts from Brazil, Canada, Germany, United Kingdom and the United States of America also participated on invitation.

(c) The Report of the Panel meeting which was organised by the United Nations and hosted by India will come out as a United Nations Document for submission to the United Nations Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space.
